



## **MINUTES**

### **Item 1:**

To formally introduce the Board of Studies Members to each other. Ms. Prajakta Joshi welcomed and introduced all the members.

### **Item 2:**

To discuss, finalize and approve the draft syllabi for the approval of academic council. Syllabi for Semester I and II were presented by Ms. Prajakta Joshi.

BoS members discussed and suggested following changes:

#### **I] Name of the Department:**

1. Dr. Srivaramangai mentioned a correction in the Department name. Department name must be Information Technology and Data Science under which Program Name can be B.Sc. (IT) or B.Sc. (Data Science).

#### **I] B.Sc.(IT) SEM I and II MAJOR:**

1. Dr. Sushil had an opinion that C and C++ are old programming languages and can be replaced with latest programming language.
2. In the discussion, Ms. Firdous mentioned that C/C++ helps learner to understand basic programming logic, which is useful in advanced programming language.
3. Basic concepts of C is required for hardware development language such as embedded C hence after detail discussion it is been decided to keep C and C++ for the coming academic year and further decision will be taken based on learner's feedback.
4. Dr. Hemlatha suggested to add K-map with 4-5 variables in Digital Electronics and Logic Design syllabi. Suggestions are being incorporated and revised syllabi of this course is being reviewed and approved by the members.

#### **II] B.Sc.(IT) SEM I OEC (DISCRETE MATHEMATICS COMPULSARY):**

1. Dr. Srivaramangai suggested to adjust Discrete Mathematics in other vertical instead of Open Elective.
2. Other members agreed that Discrete Mathematics is an important course for IT learners hence it cannot be kept as an elective.
3. Upon further discussion with the chair, it is been finalised that Discrete Mathematics will be offered as a compulsory course and learner can choose Any One from other OE courses.

#### **III] B.Sc.(IT) SEM I VSC:**

1. Dr. Sushil suggested to remove question wise aims from Practical courses and to replace with concepts based practical experiments.

#### **IV] B.Sc.(IT) SEM I and II SEC:**

1. Dr. Hemlatha suggested to add spell check, case study to create website in Web Designing with HTML. Suggestions are being incorporated and revised syllabi of these course is being reviewed and approved by the members.
2. Dr. Hiren suggested to remove conditional and looping statements from Web Designing with JavaScript course and to add JQuery.

**V] B.Sc.(IT) SEM I VEC (REPLACE DIGITAL ETHICS WITH GREEN IT):**

1. Dr. Hiren suggested to remove Digital Ethics course as the basic concepts required to understand this course are not being taught to first year learners.
2. It is been suggested to introduce Green IT for first year and Digital Ethics can be offered in later year.
3. With the permission of chair, it's been finalised to offer Green IT instead of Digital Ethics.

**VI] B.Sc.(IT) SEM II AEC (REPLACE MOBILE PROGRAMMING WITH ADVANCED COMMUNICATION):**

1. Dr. Srivaramangai and Dr. Ganesh mentioned that language based courses must be offered under AEC, hence to remove Mobile Programming.
2. Upon further discussion with the chair, it is been finalised to offer Advanced Communication instead of Mobile Programming.

**VII] B.Sc.(IT) SEM II MINOR:**

1. Dr. Srivaramangai mentioned that courses offered under Minor must be in progressive manner, hence to remove Cyber Laws and replace with some other department or other stream courses.
2. Upon further discussion with the chair, it is been decided to keep this course for the coming academic year and further decision will be taken for the next year batch.

**VIII] COURSES OFFERED TO OTHER DEPARTMENTS:**

1. All members suggested not to offer Introduction to Artificial Intelligence course for first year learners as the concepts are very vast for their intellectual. After discussion with chair, it is been decided to keep this course for the coming academic year and further decision will be taken based on learner's feedback.
2. Dr. Sushil suggested to offer MS-Office in semester I and as per the need Advanced Excel can be offered in semester II and new course is been introduced as Fundamentals of Excel.

**Item 3:**

1. Examination question paper pattern of 3, 2 and 1 credit courses for Internal assessment and Term-end examination is been reviewed by the members. Dr. Sushil suggested to conduct MCQs test instead of Presentation / Viva-voce for 10 marks Internal assessment.
2. Term-end examination question paper pattern is been appreciated by all the members and approved with no change.

**Item 4:**

The eligibility norms for admission in the B.Sc.(IT) is been finalised as follows

1. Candidate securing minimum 45% in 12<sup>th</sup> std. along with Mathematics/Statistics/Mathematics and Statistics subject is eligible.



**RESOLUTION:**

1. The Chairman informed the Board that certain courses of the First Year of certain programs (list attached) carry 3 credits. As per University guidelines, the assessment pattern for courses carrying 3 credits must be for 75 marks. However, inadvertently, the assessment pattern approved in the Board earlier was for 100 marks. The Chairman informs the Board that the error is regretted and proposes that the assessment pattern for courses carrying 3 credits be revised for a maximum of 75 marks, instead of 100 marks with retrospective effect. The revised assessment pattern would consist of 30 marks internal assessment and 45 marks external assessment. The rubrics for the assessment have been modified to reflect the change in the assessment pattern.
2. The chairman informed the Board that internal assessment for these courses have been conducted as per the rubrics approved for 100 marks assessment ie. 40 marks. The chairman proposes that the marks obtained by the students for the courses carrying 3 credits be proportionately converted from 40 marks assessment to 30 marks assessment.
3. The courses for the following courses of various Programmes were approved by the Board after deliberation, discussion and after making appropriate changes:
