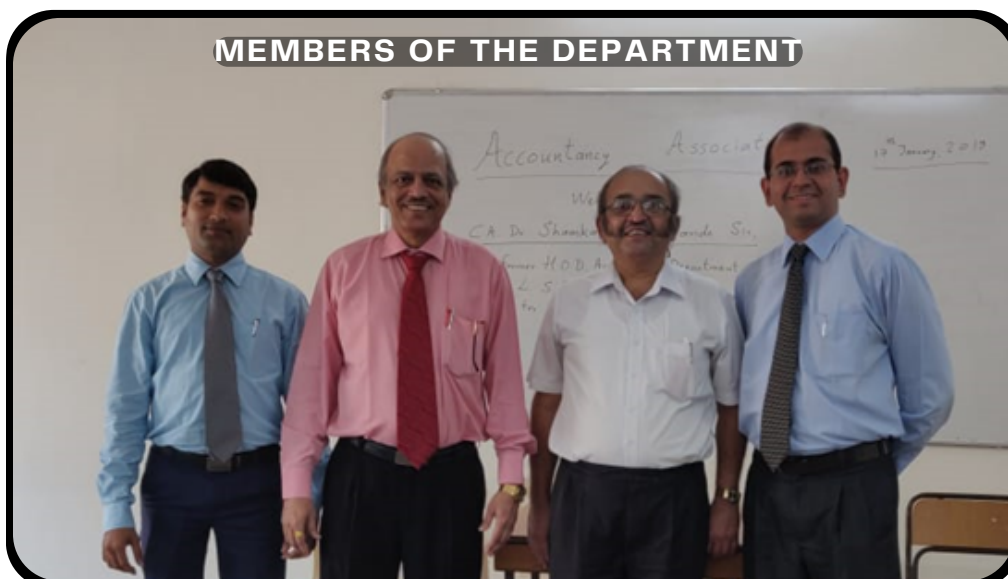


INTRODUCTION:

How are your courses managed?

Counselling is done to students of First Year about Second Year subjects. Counselling is done to Second Year students about Third Year subjects. Direct & Indirect Tax subject is offered on merit basis.

Is there an appropriate and up-to-date teaching and learning strategy in the Department?

Teaching Plan is prepared at the beginning of each semester. Time table is prepared as per work load for every teacher. Lecture taken record is prepared at the end of every week. At the end of the semester, Special Guidance Lectures are organised for the students to revise the entire syllabus.

How are teaching and learning organised for students?

Chalk and board method is used generally. Theoretical aspects are explained through Power Point presentations. Practical examples are given in the subjects like taxation, auditing. Actual Balance Sheets, Annual Reports & Audit Reports are shown to the students for study of practical aspects. Fluctuating financial parameters are studied through live movements on websites. Guest lectures are organised for latest issues in Accountancy and Taxation. Power Point presentation is given as a crash course to cover entire syllabus as a revision at the end of the semester.

How do you encourage students' participation in the classroom and enhance student learning?

Group Discussions in the class. Each student is invited on the stage to explain the concept to judge the understanding and to improve communication skills. Surprise tests are taken in the class to find out students' understanding of the topics taught. Discussion on current developments
