MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of understanding (MOU) is executed and entered on this 13th day of July, 2022, sets the terms and understanding between The Parkinson's Disease & Movement Disorder Society (PDMDS) and the Psychology Department of SES's L.S. Raheja College of Arts and Commerce to jointly enable students to understand various aspects of Parkinson's disease and spread awareness about the condition.

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I. Background

About PDMDS

Parkinson's Disease and Movement Disorder Society (PDMDS) is a not-for-profit organization registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950, Registration Number F 23879 Mumbai on 11th April 2002. PDMDS provides support for patients suffering from Parkinson's Disease and Movement Disorder. It provides multidisciplinary rehabilitation to People with Parkinson's and their caregivers, undertake patient welfare initiatives for those from socio economically disadvantaged backgrounds, provide individualized care initiatives through home outreach and individual counseling to those in need, training and development of professionals, development of resources and dissemination of information through publications, booklets, audiovisuals, handouts, and newsletters and sensitize the general public about Parkinson's and its symptoms.

About L.S. Raheja College

The Sadhana Education Society's L.S. Raheja College of Arts and Commerce, permanently affiliated to the University of Mumbai, is a cornerstone of academic excellence that creates an ambience conducive to the learning process. The aim of the college is to impart education in the faculties of arts and commerce at the undergraduate level and in the Faculty of Commerce up to the Post-graduate level leading to Ph.D in commerce. The college provides liberal facilities in both spheres: curricular and extra-curricular.

II. Purpose of the MOU

The purpose of this partnership is for students to educate and spread awareness about Parkinson's Disease.

The above purpose will be accomplished by undertaking the following:

1. Observer ship and assistantship- The students will observe, interact with people with Parkinson's Disease and assist the therapists in online sessions and in physical session under the guidance of the PDMDS. This guided observation and interaction will provide them with an opportunity to learn through their experience. Maximum of 15 students would be taken for the certificate course in one academic year.
2. Awareness program -The students will raise awareness about Parkinson's through strategies like presentation of information about Parkinson's to targeted groups, creating posters, writing articles in the college magazine or any other publication, awareness surveys, making short videos etc. All materials produced and delivery of presentations for the awareness programs will be under the supervision of the PDMDS.
3. Research - Students will conduct desk research to develop a resource booklet and submit it for evaluation to the PDMDS. Students who have successfully participated and have submitted a report at the end of the course will be felicitated with a certificate.

III. Duration of the MOU:

The course is a minimum of 30 hours. As it is self-paced learning students will have to complete it between August to December each academic year.

IV. Meeting and Reporting:

Meeting will be at a centre mutually selected for observership by the student and PDMDS. This will be on the day of the week that the selected centre functions. Awareness programmes and research will be flexible and done by the students during the period of the course. A report will be submitted at the end of the course.

V. Validity period of the MOU:

The MOU will stand valid for two academic years, that is upto May, 2024. The MOU can be terminated by either party by giving one month's notice.

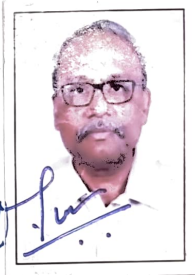
