GUIDELINES


- ❑ Library Working hours : 10 a.m. to 4.p.m. (Closed on Weekend)

WHAT IS NCC?

- The National Cadet Corps or NCC, Youth Wing of Indian Armed forces, is the world's largest uniformed youth organization.
- Its headquarters is located in New Delhi, India. This organization is open to school and college students on a voluntary basis.
- The National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization, It consists of the Army, Navy and Air Wing. Comprising the Army, Navy, and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens.
- NCC recruits cadets from high schools, colleges, and universities all across India.
- The Cadets are provided with basic military training in small arms and parades. After completing the course, the officers and cadets have no liability for active military service.

MOTTO OF N. C.C.

"UNITY AND DISCIPLINE"

- It aims to develop discipline, character, brotherhood, the spirit of adventure.
- It also focuses to enlighten leadership qualities among youth who are ready to serve the nation. NCC also motivates youth to choose a career in the Armed Forces(Defence).

AIMS OF N. C. C

- The NCC aims at developing character, comradeship, discipline, a secular outlook, the spirit of adventure and ideals of selfless service amongst young citizens.
- To Create a Human Resource of Organized, Trained and Motivated Youth, To Provide Leadership in all Walks of life and be Always Available for the Service of the Nation.
- To Provide a Suitable Environment to Motivate the Youth to Take Up a Career in the Armed Forces.
- To Develop Character, Comradeship, Discipline, Leadership, Secular Outlook, Spirit of Adventure, and Ideals of Selfless Service amongst the Youth of the Country.

BENEFITS OF JOINING NCC

- NCC is a highly reputed body. In fact, it is a second line of defence.
- If students want to make it their career option, NCC cadets will get a lot of weight. As they are directly connected with the ministry of defence, they will get to learn several things and entitled to receive Rs. 700.
- In addition to this, they will also get a chance to learn several valuable things, including selflessness, honesty, discipline, and hard work.
- Additionally, they will know how to build confidence and gain leadership qualities.
- NCC camps are held all across India. Hence, students will get opportunities to visit new places and learn the art of independence.
- Along with military activities, students will also get to learn other skills, including parachuting, paragliding, and basic aviation courses.

On a serious note, the best way to join the Indian Army, Air Force or Navy is by being a part of something national. And what's better than National Cadet Corps? Not to mention, that you get special privilege when you give interviews and competitive examinations.

CERTIFICATES & EXAMINATION

There are Three Certificates in NCC. Below describes about it from lower value to higher value:-

- **Certificate – A** : It can be taken by JD/JW cadets of the NCC, during class year 8 and 9. After passing those classes it can't be obtained. The candidate must have attended a minimum 75% of total training periods laid down in the syllabus for the first and second years of JD/JW NCC (All Wings). The candidate must have attended one Annual Training Camp.
- **Certificate – B** : It can be taken by SD/SW cadets of the NCC, after class year 10 and those studying for a degree. The candidate must have attended a minimum 75% of total training periods laid down in the syllabus for the first and second years of SD/SW NCC (All Wings). The cadet must have attended one Annual Training Camp/NIC. Cadets who possess Certificate - A will be awarded 10 bonus marks. An air wing cadet must do a minimum 10 Glider launches.
- **Certificate – C** : Is the highest level certificate for NCC cadets. It can be taken in the 3rd year of training, in the 3rd year of degree course. Those who possess a Certificate - B can take it in the first year after their +2, and in the 1st year of their degree. The cadet must have attended two Annual Training Camps or one Annual Training Camp and one of the following: RD Camp Delhi, Centrally Organised Camp, Para Training Camp, Attachment Training with service units, National Integration Camp, Youth Exchange Programme, or Foreign Cruise (Navy Wing only).

HOW TO JOIN NCC?

To join NCC, you will be required to meet the eligibility criteria. Check out the required age limit and educational qualification to join NCC here:

❑ **Age Limit – How To Join NCC**

- Junior Wing – 13 years to 18½ years
- Senior Wing – Up to 26 years

❑ **Educational Qualification – How To Join NCC**

- Candidates must be a citizen of India or Nepal.
- Must be enrolled in an educational institution
- Have a good moral character
- Meet the prescribed medical standards

❑ **How To Enroll?**

- Students who are willing to enroll in the Junior Division can apply to the Headmaster of the school providing the unit or part thereof.
- Students who are willing to enroll in the Senior Division can apply to the Officer commanding the unit.
